



Overview

- This intensive simulates what a Member of Parliament encounters when he or she drafts and advocates for legislation.
- Students begin by drafting legislation in a small committee and progress to an official legislative session where they have the opportunity to debate and vote on their legislation.
- Participants must choose between competing priorities, personal legislative goals, the goals of their party, and professional agreements made with other participants.
