

iAdvocate Congress Simulation

Overview

- iAdvocate simulates what a legislator encounters when he or she drafts and advocates for legislation.
- Students begin by drafting legislation in a small committee, and progress to an official legislative session where they have the chance to debate and vote on their legislation.
- Students must choose between competing priorities, personal legislative goals, party goals, and professional agreements made with other participants.
